If you are planning to go to university after Oriel Sixth Form then here is what you should be doing this term:

YEAR 13

Complete final draft of Personal Statement in Unifrog. Get a subject specialist to review it in Unifrog and act upon their advice

- Check with your teachers what you Predicted Grade for UCAS purposes will be and ensure it matches your final course choice entry requirements.
- Book a checking appointment with Mrs Slayford to go through your completed UCAS form
- Complete your application in UCAS and send it to us
- COMPLETED and CHECKED by 13th December

YEAR 12

- RESEARCH universities and courses.
- Use the Unifrog Search Tool, Subject Library and Careers Library to finalise your ideas about what to study
- Create Shortlists in UNIFROG.
- Complete Supercurricular activities that will make you a strong applicant.
- Lock in Work Experience that will enhance your application.

Year 12 should all be in the process of securing their WORK EXPERIENCE placement for the final week of the Spring Term.

Students have been shown how to search the database of placements and to approach potential employers directly via letter or email and then follow up with a call.

Mr Thornton is available for advice, support and to provide the paperwork once a student has an agreement in principle to a Work Experience placement.

Paperwork must be completed in plenty of time for us to pay for an external provider to carry out Health and Safety checks on the employer.
