If you are planning to go to university after Oriel Sixth Form then here is what you should be doing this term:

YEAR 13

Keep an eye on UCAS Track - your offers will be coming in via this platform. When your last decision comes in go to Track to make your replies. You'll have a deadline shown in Track to do this by – remember your personal deadline might be different to your friends!

These are the types of reply you can make.

- Firm acceptance this is your first choice.
- Insurance acceptance the back-up choice.
- Decline you'll need to decline any other offers you get.

However, if you decide you don't want to accept any of the offers, you can decline them all and add more courses in the 'Extra' service. Alternatively, you can see what courses still have vacancies later on in our Clearing service.
