Time moves fast and we find ourselves now at another critical junction in their education pathway. With the spotlight firmly on Covid matters, it is easy for to forget that now is the time of year, that YIIs up and down the country need to be making choices about their future educational pathway.

We will be running Careers sessions in school, whereby students will be taken out of normal lessons for one period, and given vital information to help them with their decisions.

During the sessions we will be discussing the different pathways post 16, including Sixth Form and Colleges; we will also be discussing the various different qualifications and routes

We will discuss the important issues of legality regarding what students are required to do post 16, and deliver information on the range of choices of establishment available to them.

The Oriel Sixth Form offer goes live online next week! You will be able to view the prospectus for next academic year and watch online content and videos to give you a feel for what student life is all about in Sixth Form. Applications go live the following week, and forms can be collected from your mentor or downloaded from the website. Applications should be given in during the Priority Application Window (23rd Nov—

15th Jan). As with all deadlines it is important to meet this one. Applications given in before the deadline will be used to try and develop a timetable for next year, ensuring as many students as possible who have Oriel as an option choice, will be able to study the full compliment of their first choice subjects.

But it is not just Oriel that students should be looking at. We would encourage students to look at lots of options of further

study, and to apply to more than one institution. Various education providers around the area are running virtual open days and events throughout November and January, with differing deadlines for applications. Some providers will be able to offer more vocational pathways that include diverse subjects from Viticulture (Wine making) - Outdoor and Adventurous Activities or Aeronautical engineering.
