Level 3 Cambridge Technical in Health and Social Care have been developed to meet the changing needs of the sector and prepare students for the challenges that they will face in higher education or employment. Designed in collaboration with experts across the sector, these vocational qualifications focus on the skills, knowledge and understanding that today's universities and employers demand.



Course structure

The OCR Level 3 Technical Diploma is equivalent in size to 2 A Levels and is for students intending to study further towards a degree, probably in the health and social care sector, alongside a further qualification related to their chosen field. The Extended Certificate is equivalent in size to one A Level.

How will I be assessed?

The Diploma will be taught over 720 guided learning hours and has 5 examinations and 7 units of internally assessed coursework, with practical elements included.

The Extended Certificate will be taught over 360 guided learning hours and has 3 examinations and 3 units of internally assessed coursework.

Entrance Requirements

We prefer you to have achieved at least a Grade C in GCSE Maths and a C in English Language. You can follow this course if you have completed BTEC Level 2 Health and Social Care although this is not essential.

5 or more GCSE or equivalent passes at grades A*-C across 5 or more subjects.
