Year 10 Lateral Flow Testing: Test 1, Tuesday 9th March

Dear Year 10 students and families,

Thank you to those families who have returned consent forms regarding the Lateral Flow Testing for Year 10 students. Our Year 10 students' first test will take place on Tuesday 9th March. Students will arrive in school at an allotted time, mentor group by mentor group. See below for each mentor group's time

Students do not need to wear school uniform when attending school for their test. Students must not have had anything to eat or drink up to 30 minutes before taking the test as this could void the result.

Students must observe the following Social Distancing guidelines:


- Arrive alone, and enter school through the Main Reception
- Queue as directed by teaching staff standing 2 metres apart from other students before entrance into the Test Centre (the Main Hall).
- Wear a mask at all times (unless exempt), until directed to remove it in the Test Centre.

When students enter the Test Centre they must follow the specific directions of our staff and listen carefully to instructions, cooperating fully with staff. Students should look at the attached 'How To' guide to familiarise themselves with the nature of the testing process.

Once Students have completed their test they must go straight home.

Students/parents will then receive the test result via the Test and Trace programme (this will be delivered to the email/mobile registered on the consent form). Parents will only be contacted by Oriel if a students' test returns a positive result. Students receiving a negative test result should return to full time face to face lessons on Wednesday 10th March.
